

The DELTA PI/SIGMA PI Scholarship Foundation



This scholarship opportunity is available for those currently enrolled in a university, college, or a accredited trade school and to be used for undergraduate or post graduate education. Funds will be distributed directly to the educational institution for use of tuition and not directly to the awardee.

Who is Eligible?

Eligibility is limited to applicants who meet all of the following:

- An active brother of the Delta Pi fraternity. Or, an active Delta Pi/ Sigma Pi Alumni or their immediate family*
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5
- Must attend a college, university, vocation, or trade school based in the USA.
- Must be a high school graduate

**Immediate family is defined as any legal children or legal grandchildren of a Delta Pi /Sigma Pi alumnus*

How Do I Apply?

The required materials for a complete application is as follows:

- A completed application form
- Unofficial school transcripts (*Awardee may be required to submit official transcripts prior to award*)
- An essay (*not to exceed 700 words*) addressing the following prompt: Discuss your educational and career goals and how this scholarship will help achieve those goals. **Please note:** *Essays exceeding the word-count limit will not be considered.*
- **Three letters of recommendation are required:** Please provide one letter from a school official, one letter from a Delta Pi/Sigma Pi Alumni member. The third letter can be from whomever you choose. Letters of Recommendation should be submitted with the application.

When is the Deadline?

Please submit the entire application package by: **17 May 2024**

(Applications received after the deadline will not be considered. Any awarded scholarship will be returned to the scholarship foundation if student does not attend school in awarded semester. Failure to complete an awarded semester requires return of awarded scholarship.)

Please provide detailed answers for all the application questions and submit all required attachments. All information received from applicants will be maintained in confidence.
